Sir,

This has reference to your application dated 3rd July, 2001 requesting to permit your trust to start new M.C.A. college at Bandra, Mumbai and admit students to the First Year of M.C. A. class for the academic year 2001-2002.

In this connection, I am directed to inform you that considering the permission granted by the Government of Maharashtra and All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi to your trust as per the Government Resolution and A.I.C.T.E. letter referred to above and without assuming any responsibility to the violation of provisions of the act that might have occurred before granting Government permission to your college, the Vice-Chancellor under the power conferred on him under Section 14(7) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 has granted permission to your trust to start a new M.C.A. college at Bandra, Mumbai - 400 051 on permanently no grant basis and admit 30 students for First Year M.C.A. Class of the three year degree course for the academic year 2001-2002 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions :-

1. To fulfill the conditions of admitting number of students and other conditions prescribed by the A.I.C.T.E. and Government from time to time;
2. To fulfill the conditions laid down by the University from time to time;
3. Admissions should not be linked with donations.
4. Minimum attendance of all the students must not be less than 75% during the academic year and college will have to complete syllabus of all the subjects during the year;
5. That they will strictly follow the Ordinance 2302, in respect of preventing the colleges and the managements of colleges from accepting donations or capitation fee for admission of students in the colleges, quoted in the University Circular No. Aff./Recog./ 49 of 1987 dated 4th February, 1987 a copy of which is enclosed herewith.
