# Juhu Beach Clean-up Drive Date:4<sup>th</sup> June 2022








### Aazadi ka Amrit Mohostav Tree Plantation Drive

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

#### PURPOSE:

The purpose is to work together and engage student volunteers from the Late Bhausaheb Hiray Smarnika Samiti Trust Institute of Computer Application in individual volunteering opportunities and group volunteering events, with the ultimate goal of serving the NGO community that ConnectFor works with and upskilling the students to build their profile and create social value.

This Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) sets the terms and understanding between -

The Late Bhausaheb Hiray Smarnika Samiti Trust Institute of Computer Application is a leading academic institution with central campuses located in Bandra, Mumbai. This institution started the M.C.A. course in 2001 after seeking approval from the AICTE and is affiliated with the University of Mumbai. All students are selected based on an entrance test covering topics on aptitude and computer concepts.

#### And

Rosy Blue Foundation, a non-profit organization registered under the Companies Act, 1956, has its registered office at 1608-09 Prasad Chambers, Opera House, Mumbai-400 004.

ConnectFor, is a programme of the Rosy Blue Foundation that seeks to contribute to the developmental sector by facilitating engagement in the volunteering community, building capacity, and creating value-added services for NGOs. Founded by Shloka Ambani and Maniti Shah, ConnectFor is a free-of-cost digital volunteering platform that matches and connects volunteers to NGOs to fulfil their various volunteering requirements. The platform has a pool of 60,000+ volunteers and partnerships with 500+ NGOs in India.



Hiray College - MCA Department, and ConnectFor may be referred to individually as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties".

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

# **ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES: Hiray College - MCA Department**

- 1. Collaborate with ConnectFor to engage students in community services/ volunteering opportunities with ConnectFor's partner NGOs.
- 2. Introduce ConnectFor to the students during orientations, sessions, and webinars in college. and/or introduce ConnectFor to conduct an orientation annually with the students and/or parents to get them acquainted with volunteering.
- 3. Share details (name, number, email ID) for students who will engage with ConnectFor.
- 4. Ensure engagement of students for ConnectFor's monthly weekend volunteering events.
- 5. Taking responsibility for ensuring that the students maintain a code of conduct while volunteering with ConnectFor's partner NGOs.
- 6. Year on year, until the validity of the MOU, Hiray College MCA Department will have to lease with the NGOs through ConnectFor and provide the data of the student volunteers to ConnectFor. Hiray College - MCA Department cannot directly approach ConnectFor's NGO partners. Any communication with ConnectFor's partner NGOs for current and future collaborations must be redirected via ConnectFor's team to ensure easy and systematic communication, coordination, and resolution of any grievances by either party.
- 7. At the end of each academic year, that is, the 30th of April of every year, until the validity of the MOU, Hiray College - MCA Department will provide ConnectFor with an acknowledgement letter for the engagement done and activities performed.

## The students are expected to:

- Select a ConnectFor Partner NGO working with social causes that interest them -ConnectFor will guide them in this process of identifying a non-profit organisation to volunteer/intern with.
- Choose volunteering opportunities available on our platform based on their interests and skills - ConnectFor will help connect the students with a relevant organization.
- Complete the volunteering activity within the prescribed deadline.

#### ConnectFor:

- ConnectFor will provide:
  - A) Registration on its platform so that students/group members can have access to multiple individual volunteering opportunities, internships, and weekend volunteering events for them to choose from.
  - B) A list of opportunities that students/group members can browse based on their skill set of the students/group members. We will be assisting the students/group members by



identifying the best match for them and connecting them to the NGO.

#### 2. ConnectFor can:

A) Organize a mixer with the students/group members, and NGOs - This will help facilitate their conversation with the NGOs that they will be connected to. OR

B) Reach out to the students/group members on call to understand their preferences, skills, and time commitments and connect them to the NGO via email.

- 3. ConnectFor will do fortnightly follow-ups with NGOs and volunteers to track the progress of the volunteers.
- 4. ConnectFor NGO partners will provide certificates to all students/group members upon completion of the project/volunteering task assigned.

# **MEETING AND REPORTING:**

The nature and medium of the volunteering roles will be online, considering the safety of the students. In the case of an outreach activity/offline group activity, the teacher in charge of the college should be present. The students will be expected to communicate as per the suggested timeline with the ConnectFor representative assigned to them. This would be for tracking the progress of their volunteering role with ConnectFor's partner NGOs.

- will be able to fulfil the following missions of the college, i.e., to sensitize students on social issues and to enable students to contribute positively to the growth and development of the nation.

#### ConnectFor:

Will benefit by connecting with talented and action-oriented human resources (volunteers) with a variety of skill sets to create an impact for the non-profits in various cause verticals listed by ConnectFor to bring a positive impact in society.

#### Students:

Will learn to utilize and implement their subject knowledge, skills, talents, and ideas by participating in volunteer activities with NGOs to flourish and create an impact on the lives



of multiple beneficiarles with their efforts.

- Volunteering with ConnectFor will be beneficial not only for the students' personal development but also for their career growth. This would help them with -
  - (i) developing new skills.
  - (ii) building on their existing skills.
  - (iii) gaining in-depth knowledge of how the development sector works.
  - (iv) imbibe social commitment.

### **CONFIDENTIALITY:**

This Agreement and all information exchanged between the Parties under this Agreement or during the negotiations preceding this Agreement are confidential to them and may not be disclosed to any third party other than that Information that is publicly available. #### INDEMNITY:

Both parties agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the other party and its directors, officers, agents, and employees ("Indemnitees"), from any direct claims, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses at actual (including reasonable legal fees and expenses) arising out of, or related to (i) either party's Content; (ii) the Use of the Service(s); (iii) loss of information and data breaches; (iv) the violation of the Agreement, (v) loss arising from the use of third-party service providers or its violation of any proprietary or other rights of both parties or any other parties involved including but not limited to other entities, Users, vendors, parties to the agreement, partners, etc of both parties or any third-party; (v) the placement or transmission of any message, information, software, or other materials; (vi) breach of any confidentiality obligations owed to

The parties shall under no circumstances be liable for indirect or consequential damages such as another. loss of use, loss of business, loss of data, loss of rights, loss of services, loss of goodwill, Third-Party to the extent that they represent the indirect loss of a Third Party, loss of revenues or anticipated savings, or any indirect financial loss or indirect economic loss, or for any indirect or consequential loss or damage whatsoever suffered by the other party.

# VALIDITY PERIOD OF THE MOU:

The MOU will be valid for three academic years. That is up to March 31, 2025, and will be reviewed annually at the end of each academic year.

## WITHDRAWAL:

Either party may withdraw from this MOU by providing written communication to the other party. The said communication shall be sent by recorded delivery with advance notice of 30 days. It is agreed that the withdrawal shall not result in either party being liable to compensate the other, over and above the consideration payable for services rendered (if any) before the date of termination.
